ATELIER VAN LIESHOUT



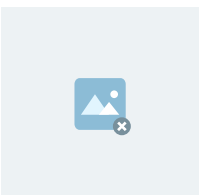

The sculptural Liberty Lounger is made out of American walnut. It comes with a soft sheepskin.

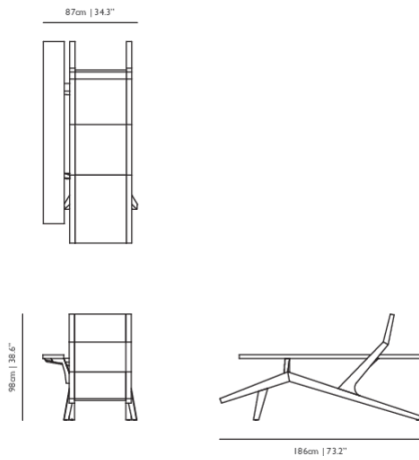
